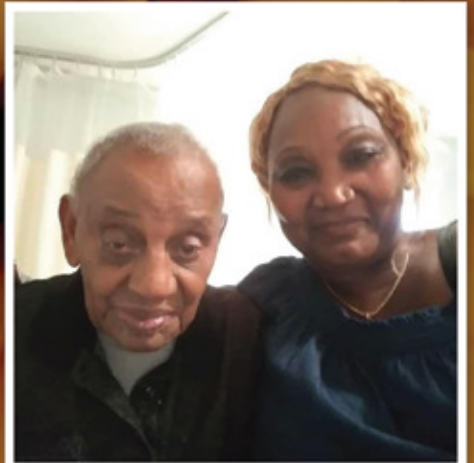
PSALM 23

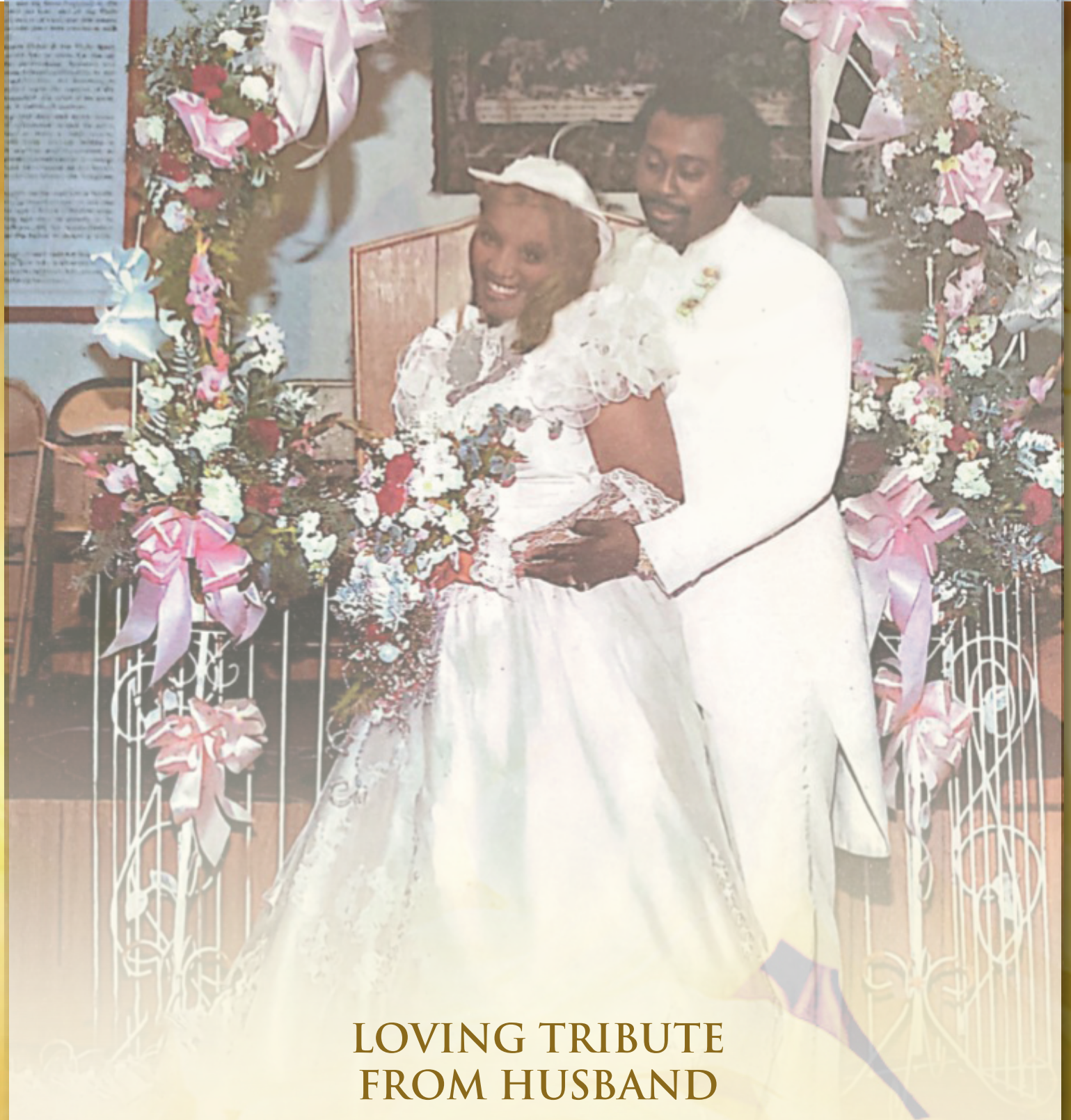
A Psalm of David.
