

John Bauman was born September 13, 1926 in Castlewood, South Dakota, the son of John and Anna (Steck) Bauman. He attended Westmar College in Le Mars, Iowa for 3 years and served in the United States Army from September 1945 to May 1947. He married Paulline "Pat" Groeneweg on June 15,

1955 at the Pioneer United Methodist Church in Rock Valley. Together they made their home in Rock Valley, where John was the owner/operator of Southside Service Station from 1956 until retiring in 1985.

John was a member of the Rock Valley town baseball team from 1946 to 1962, and was known on the team as "Sunny Bauman." He was very active in church and community service and was a founding member of the Rock Valley Golf Course, a member of VFW and Rock Valley Gun Club, and the Pioneer United Methodist Church. He enjoyed volunteering with Habitat for Humanity. John died Saturday, April 16, 2022 at Hegg Health Center in Rock Valley at the age of 95.

John is survived by his wife, Pat; 2 children, Terry (George) White of Council Bluffs, Iowa and Mark (Sue) Bauman of Inwood, Iowa; 2 grandchildren, Amy Bauman and Cody Bauman; and a great-granddaughter, Everly.
