Sabbath Information

Kindly Maintain Reverence and Decorum in the fitness center. Although the main auditorium is a gymnasium, it is our sanctuary and place of worship this week.

Special Seating: Lawn chairs are not permitted during the Friday evening through Sabbath evening meetings to help maximize seating. Those with special medical needs will be granted exceptions by permit at Information. During the week, special designated areas will be provided for the smaller style lawn chairs without permit. For all meetings, space will be designated for wheelchairs and other special needs.

Saving Seats: Feel free to save seats *until song service begins*. When the singing starts, any unoccupied seat (including lawn chairs) is free to be used by anyone. Refrain from using seat cushions to reserve seats.

Avoid sitting in seats that are reserved by signs for tram drivers, singers, speakers, official photographers, ushers, etc.

After each meeting, ushers will straighten up in preparation for the next service. Anything left behind, including seat cushions, will be removed and placed in Information behind the fitness center.

Exhibit Tent: Open today from 2:00 PM - 6:30 PM only.

Sabbath Parking: People with disability permits can park behind the main auditorium. An overflow lot is next to the Great Lakes Adventist Academy administration building.

Extra parking areas are located at the end of both Quarter and Deaner Roads. Refrain from moving vehicles on or onto the campground during the Sabbath hours.

No Sabbath Meals will be served in the cafeteria today.
