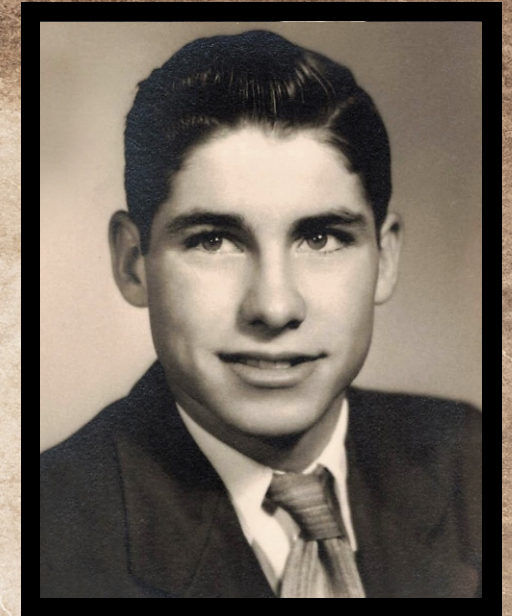

Roger Alvin Schulz, 88, of Canton, KS, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 7, 2024, surrounded by his family at Pleasant View Home, Inman.

He was born on November 21, 1935, on the family farm north of Canton, KS, the son of Glen C. and Flossie M. (Rogers) Schulz. Roger was the great-great-great-grandson of August Schulz who homesteaded in Battle Hill township, McPherson County, Kansas in

the late 1800s. He attended elementary school at the Battle Hill School House and graduated from Canton High School. On September 17, 1954, Roger was united in marriage to Geraldine "Geri" Kliever in Canton, KS. This union was blessed with two sons, Rodney and Mitchell. Geri preceded Roger in death on January 2, 2022, after 67 years of marriage.

Roger served in the United States Army and was a member of the Canton American Legion Post #192. He was also a member of Canton Community Church.
