True Wisdom, Proverbs 3:1-12 Friendship, Proverbs 17:9-17, 25:17-22, 27:6-17 Work, Proverbs 6:6-11, 24:30-34, 26:13-16 Anger, Proverbs 14:29-30, 24:28-29, 25:21-22 Speech, Proverbs 10:18-32, 12:13-19 Plans, Proverbs 16:1-9, 25, 33 This Sunday we launch a new Sunday morning sermon series. It's called *Kingdom Wisdom* and comes from the book of Proverbs. The quest for wisdom is as old as time. Yet Scripture tells us that true wisdom can only be given from our Creator who spoke the world into existence and breathed his Spirit into our souls.

I was struck by a post from Pete Grieg, founder of the 24-7 prayer movement. He was reminded of a line from T.S. Eliot, the great poet who died in 1965. He said that: 'Christ is the still point of the turning world'. Christ is to be found in the eye of the storm. This is something I am learning. In fact, with all the distractions, deletions and distortions of this turning world, it has become my necessary daily practice simply to sit in silence and stillness each morning for a few minutes, re-centering myself on the peace of his presence, re-anchoring my scattered senses in the absolute bedrock of his love.

As the New Year begins, we look to the giver of wisdom as we study the book of Proverbs. Here we will discover practical and everyday wisdom for our homes, relationships, workplaces, and daily lives. As citizens of the kingdom of God, our wisdom looks different than the wisdom taught in the world around us. Together, as we dive into Proverbs, we will be challenged to live our lives in a way that reflects the values and wisdom of the kingdom of God.
