Witnessing Before the Great Men of the Earth

**And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for
a testimony against them and the Gentiles. [Matthew 10:18](#).**

The time is not far off when the people of God will be called upon to give their testimony before the rulers of the earth.
