

Remembering the Life....

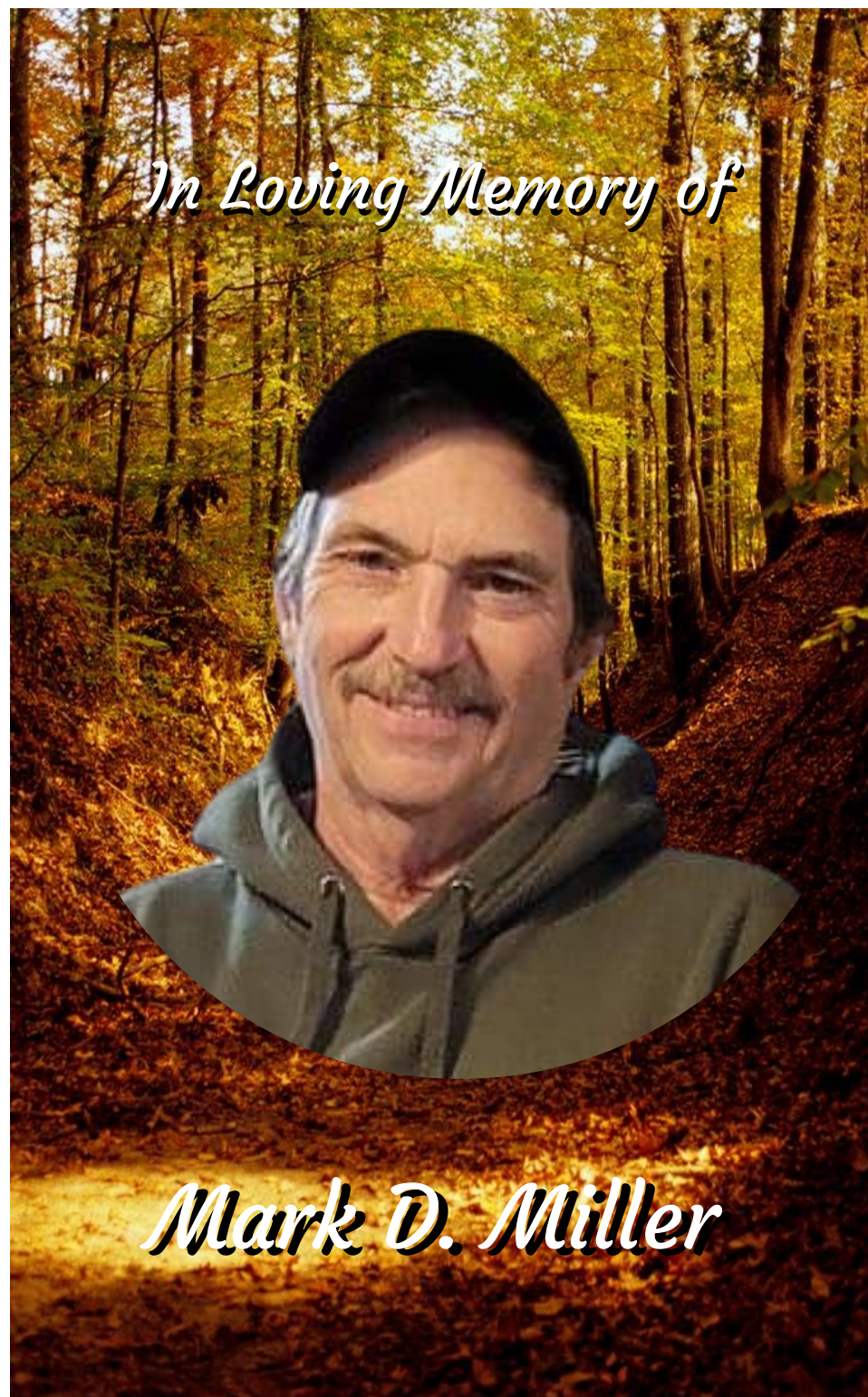

Gone Hunting

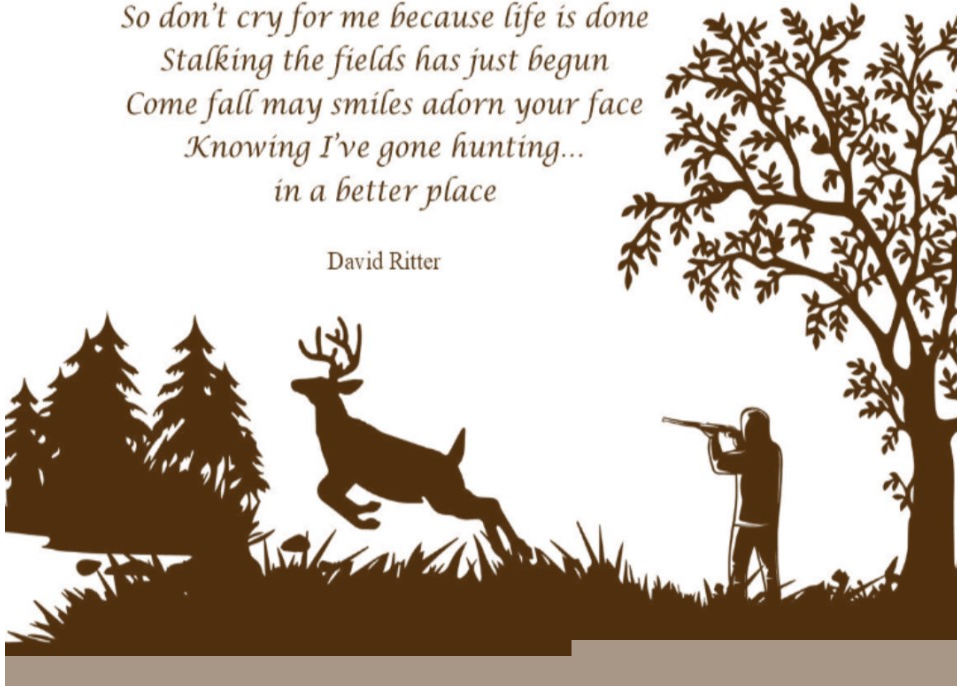
*Remember the smiles and not the tears
