The Head of Development will oversee both the Individual Giving and Institutional Partnerships teams, cultivating a highly productive and agile group of fundraising professionals dedicated to delivering extraordinary results. As a key strategic partner to the Chief Advancement Officer, the Founder and CEO, trustees, and other stakeholders, the Head of Development will play a crucial role in advancing Success Academy's dual mission of innovative education and advocacy. This role involves expanding the network of transformational donors and establishing a high-performing, scalable development program aligned with Success Academy's priorities. Additionally, the Head of Development will engage in strategic planning, driving innovation, growth, and results, and will craft and execute comprehensive plans for identifying, engaging, and stewarding high-net-worth individuals and institutional funders to ensure Success Academy exceeds its ambitious commitments to its scholars and educational initiatives.

Choosing the right school for a child is one of the most important decisions a parent will make—it will profoundly influence their outlook and success in life. As the highest-performing, free public charter school network in New York, Success Academy (SA) creates an environment where children can stretch and grow, be challenged and excel, and discover natural talents and develop resilience, all while building meaningful relationships with educators and peers.

Success Academy is redefining what is possible in education. Every day, students prove that children from all demographics can achieve in school and life when presented with the right opportunities. Success Academy fosters a love of learning while creating opportunities for children to become critical and creative thinkers, build life skills and confidence, pursue passions, and secure exceptional careers.

The dual mission at Success Academy is to build world-class K-12 public schools in NYC while advocating to change policies that prevent children from accessing excellent educational experiences. Success Academy also collaborates with social-emotional learning specialists and school psychologists to cater to the whole child, creating empowering educational experiences that nurture children's character and self-belief while growing their knowledge and academic abilities.

Success Academy believes all children should have access to an excellent education. Its mission to deliver educational equity is founded on a belief in the power of children to learn and achieve. When children have access to high-quality teaching—and supportive adults who hold them to high expectations—almost anything is within their grasp. Success Academy is committed to constant reflection and improvement, and it prioritizes diversity, equity, and inclusion in all its work.

Success Academy nurtures children's natural curiosity to help them become excited about learning. Teachers limit direct instruction, instead fostering students' independent thinking and problem solving. Students explore texts, math problems, science experiments, chess strategies, and works of art.

The continually evolving K-12 curriculum prepares students to graduate from four-year colleges or universities. To date, 100% of graduating seniors have gained admission to college, including many selective and highly selective colleges and universities.

Success Academy schools have historically ranked in the top 1% to 3% in math and reading compared to all 3,500 NY State elementary and middle schools. Last year, Success Academy students far outpaced their peers in other charter schools and the larger state and New York City district schools. Most recently, Success Academy ranked #1 in New York State in Math test scores and #3 in English Language Arts among districts with test participation rates of 95% or more. In a time when racial disparities in achievement and access to opportunities continues to persist across the city and state, no other large school district in the state came close to Success Academy's scores among Black and Hispanic students. The success at SA goes beyond state tests, though. Success Academy students have won dozens of state and national division chess titles, performed and competed internationally, claimed numerous top debate awards, signed professional sports contracts, and more.

The Success Academy school design, founded on a love of learning, offers excellent academics and a wide variety of co-curriculars that create critical thinkers and confident students who are set up for a lifetime of success.

FROM THE CHIEF ADVANCEMENT OFFICER

Success Academy was founded in 2006 with the mission of reimagining public education as an excellent, efficient, and equitable pillar of American society. In the 2024-2025 school year, our 57 schools will serve more than 22,000 scholars, kindergarten through 12th grade, in many of the lowest-income neighborhoods of New York City. As one of the nation's highest-performing districts, we stand as an exemplar and resource for educators, schools, and districts across the country. We have outperformed affluent white students on the available standardized metrics, and educators who worked and trained at Success are leading preeminent schools and districts around the country. All of our graduates—100%—have been accepted into college, and scholars from our first graduating classes are enrolled in selective colleges and universities across the country.

What Success Academy has achieved in less than two decades is unprecedented, but with the U.S. education system in profound crisis, we are redoubling our efforts. We spent more than a year carefully reexamining our design, best practices, and outcomes to chart our path forward, resulting in three interconnected major initiatives. We are growing our district by 50% over five years by adding 10,000 seats for the students who need us the most and hyper-scaling our district-level systems and infrastructure to support this growth. We are dramatically increasing the quality of our schools and how well we prepare children for college and for life—tightly integrating schooling from kindergarten through 12th grade. And to bring this vision for unparalleled excellence to life, we are building the school of the future: a landmark K-12 campus that will serve 2,400 scholars in the Bronx and demonstrate our new model for American public education.

The next Head of Development will join Success Academy at an auspicious time. We are in the final two years of a five-year, \$500 million campaign, and exceeding that goal is within our sights. As a key thought partner and collaborator with our dynamic Founder and CEO Eva Moskowitz and with me, as well as a leader among our team of dedicated Advancement professionals, the Head of Development will not only be integral to that near-term success but will have the opportunity to help architect what comes next.
