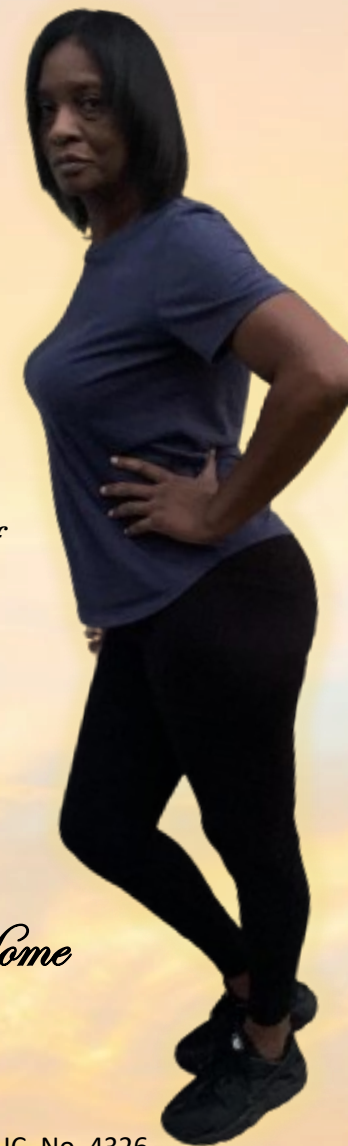




Don't say goodbye
