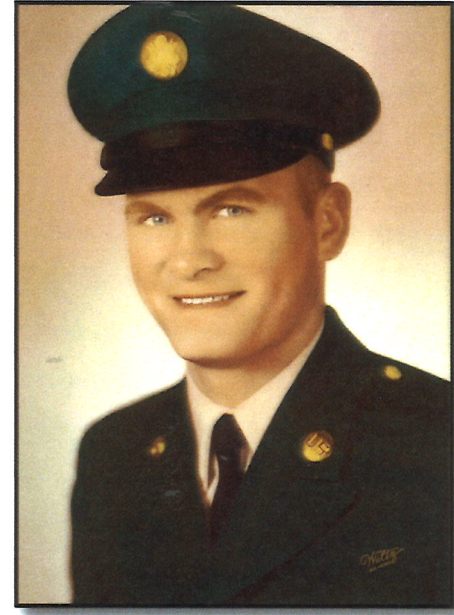

All is well, safely rest, God is nigh.*

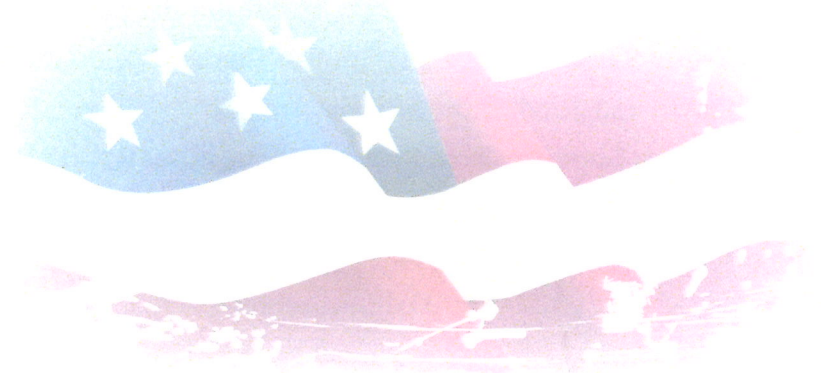
