#### Verse of the Week

- For the Holy Spirit to deepen our desperation to experience the ever expanding wonder working of God's will and power in our community."
- For the Lord to increase united, biblical, persistent, intercessory prayer in the anointing of the Holy Spirit.

#### Tuesday: Give us this day our daily bread.

##### Please Pray:

- For every person and family to receive an ample provision for their physical needs. from the vast storehouses of God's kingdom.
- For every person and family to receive an abundance of compassion and divine care from the Hand of our Heavenly Father.
- For every person and family to receive the soul sustaining Word of God.

#### Wednesday: Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those that trespass against us.

##### Please Pray:

- For our Father in Heaven to forgive and cleanse the people of our community of injustice and lawlessness, hatred and malice, sexual immorality, robbery and theft, lying and deception, greed and selfishness.

- For our Father in Heaven to forgive and cleanse the people in our community from all kinds of unrighteousness, arrogance, selfish ambition, bitterness and unforgiveness.
- For our Father in Heaven to release His grace in Jesus Christ into our community and region so that people will forgive one another as the Lord has forgiven them.

**Thursday: Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.**

**Please Pray:**

- For our Almighty God to deliver our community and region from entrenched evil.
- For our Almighty God to tear down the strongholds of cursing, idolatry, witchcraft, perversion, injustice and prejudice in all forms throughout our community
- For Father, Son and Holy Spirit to bless our community with all forgiving grace, personal honesty, teachable receptivity, humble servanthood, faithful service, family unity, loving discipline, genuine friendships, purity in relationships.

**Friday: Please Persist in Prayer for Pastors and Ministry Leaders**

**Please Pray this prayer:**

- For the hearts of all our intercessors to ignite in prayer for them.
- For every pastor and ministry leader to receive the Fire of the Lord today.
- For people to respond to the message of salvation, to personal visitations and other expressions of pastoral care.

**Sabbath: Pray for the entire Conference to intercede for the Central Region**
