

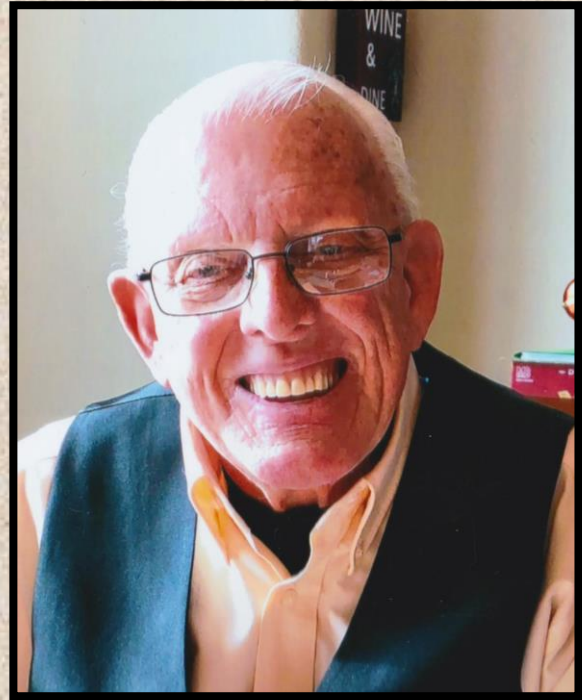
OBITUARY
