



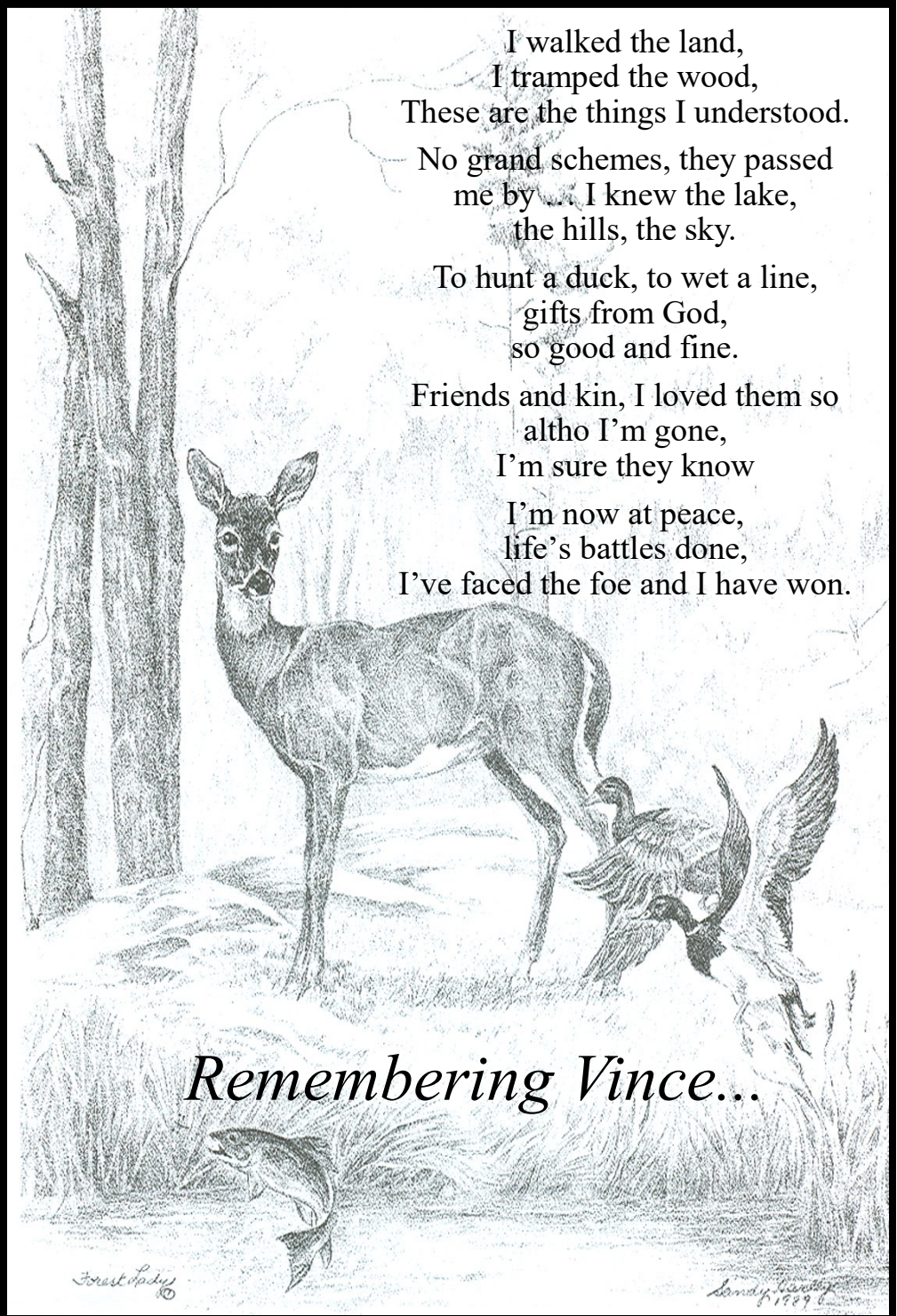
*Vincent M. Paskey, 85, Detroit Lakes, MN died suddenly
