Good news update on Asher: from Delvin,



Over the last couple of weeks, we have been learning a lot about Aplastic Anemia, a disease we had never heard of before. Only 600 to 900 Americans are diagnosed with Aplastic Anemia each year. The most promising treatment is a sibling matched bone marrow transplant. God has answered our prayers! We learned yesterday that Reagan and Asher have matching tissue types.

We are hoping to start this treatment soon. Asher still has a long road to recovery. Even after the treatment, Asher will continue to rely on blood donations to provide him with platelets and red blood cells until he builds up enough healthy bone marrow to take over. We are so grateful for all of you who have donated or plan to donate blood. Please continue to pray for us as Asher and Reagan prepare for this procedure, and for a quick and complete recovery for Asher and Reagan after the procedure.

Asher is blessed to have a family member who is able and very willing to donate bone marrow. Others with blood diseases do not have that option. If you are interested in finding out about bone marrow donation, check out www.bethematch.org . It only takes a cheek swab to be added to the registry, and you could save someone's life.

For those of you who live in Walla Walla, Asher's home church, that's us here at Eastgate, has a drive scheduled in a few days. It is on **Wednesday, December 11 from 12:00 – 5:00 pm**. You can search for blood drives at other times and locations at redcrossblood.org or vitalant.org. Whatever area you live in, there is somebody there who will need a blood donation. The fuller blood banks are, the more flexible they can be in providing blood to those who need it.”

City of College Place opens first electric vehicle charging station on campus of WWU

A ribbon-cutting ceremony will take place Tuesday, Dec. 10, at 11 a.m. for the first electric vehicle charging station in College Place, Washington. The charging station is located adjacent to The Express/Shell gas station, 406 S. College Ave., (corner of 4th Street and College Avenue) in College Place.

The station offers a level two charger that will provide up to 26 miles range per hour of charge for a full battery electric vehicle and up to 12 miles range per hour of charge for a plug-in hybrid vehicle. Up to four vehicles can charge concurrently at parking spaces that are designated specifically for the charging station. Charging is available free of charge, 24 hours per day.

The stations are funded by the City of College Place, Columbia Rural Electric, and *Walla Walla University*.

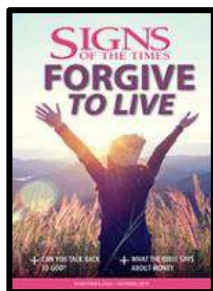

Macy's Holiday Parade of Lights – Walla Walla

Downtown Walla Walla's annual Macy's Holiday Parade of Lights is a standout event where the community comes together for a beautiful after-dark parade each December. Grab your family, a warm coat, a chair and a warm drink and join us as we kick off the holiday season. December 7, 2019 from 6:00 – 7:00pm
The staging for the parade is Alder Street between and including fifth through eighth streets. From the staging area the parade moves on Alder street east to Palouse Street then left on Main Street heading west. It continues through Sixth Street where the parade will disperse.
