The above class minimum will provide you with flex time to be used at your discretion. You can increase the time allowed for any of the areas above or add classes such as life skills, foreign language, etc.

- Thirty-minute lunch periods per day are required and cannot be included in instructional time.
- Reading for grades 1-2 should be taught 5 days a week.
- Math for grades 1-8 should be taught days a week.
- Science must be taught each week all four quarters.
- Social Studies must be taught each week all four quarters.
- Bible Labs should be incorporated into each month.
- Note: At the beginning of the year *A-Z Typing* needs to be taught at least 4 days a week, with students finishing one lesson each day. During this time, more than 40 minutes per week will be needed. Once the *A-Z Typing* program is completed, students should continue strengthening their speed/accuracy by using *Mavis Beacon* and/or *Typing Pal Online*. At this point the 40 minute minimum requirement would go into effect.
