I'm sure, like me, you will be disappointed at this news, but I also appreciate the importance to train in the right environment, it's better to realise early on and take steps before it becomes harder to make a change. We pray and wish her, and Paul and children well, as she continues her training and discernment. It means we will not have a Curate next summer which creates extra pressure on already stretched resources. But I know and trust God will provide for our needs.

parish share



At our PCC (parish governance) meeting this week Cath Hargraves, our treasurer, alerted us to a shortfall in income which impacts our ability to pay our Parish Share to the Manchester Diocese. Parish Share is a contribution towards the centralised costs of running the Diocese – the main expenditure is for clergy stipends

and housing, which makes it possible to provide clergy in every parish from the richest to the poorest areas. The PCC has committed to contribute £110,000 this calendar year, but our income has reduced, and maintenance and utility costs have increased, which mean we are currently forecast to contribute £96,000, a shortfall of £14,000. I want to make everyone aware of this need and ask if you are able, would you prayerfully consider either making a one-off extra donation to church or increase your regular giving. One way to contribute is by bank transfer to our parish CAF account, number 00030623, sort code 40-52-40. But please only contribute if you are able. And thank you so much to everyone who so generously supports the ministry and mission of St Peter's Parish.
