Church Board Actions, Nov 19, 2018:

VOTED: To approve the following recommendation by the Fellowship Hall Building Project Committee:

Fellowship Hall Building Project Financial Goal

The Building Committee wishes to inform the Church Board, that, at this point in time, it seems advisable to set a Fellowship Hall Project Financial goal of \$2,000,000. This amount may be revised, downward or upward, as additional information becomes available regarding a more definitive building cost estimate and the impact of any borrowing of funds for the project.

VOTED: To approve the following recommendation by the Fellowship Hall Building Project Committee:

Fellowship Hall Building Project Fundraising Committee Assignment

- a. Embrace the fund-raising goal set by the Board.
- b. Conduct an early assessment of financial support that could be expected by 12/31/19. This information is needed in order to prepare a financial plan for the project. The suggested time period for the assessment will be within the next 3-4 months.
- c. Assess annual levels of income for the project at least for a 5-year period.
- d. Create a goal device for display at the church.
- e. Regularly report to the board and the church on progress achieved.
- f. Work with the Church Treasurer to develop a report format that shows fund received, funds pledged and the remainder to be raised, etc.
