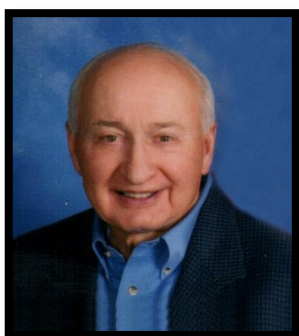


Adolph James Wagner, age 85, of Alexandria, MN, passed away Monday, July 2, 2018, at St. Cloud Hospital.
