Donna attended Minnesota District 41 country school and graduated from Morris High School. Following her graduation, Donna attended St. Cloud Teachers College in St. Cloud, MN. She was united in marriage to James Nibbe on August 23, 1953 at Zion Lutheran Church in Morris. They were blessed with five children. Donna worked as an elementary school teacher, teaching the second grade in Excelsior, MN and later as a substitute teacher in Willmar, MN.
