**Diana Lynn Morgan was born August 10, 1953, in Kansas City, Missouri to Edgar H. Freeman and Lettie B. Freeman.**

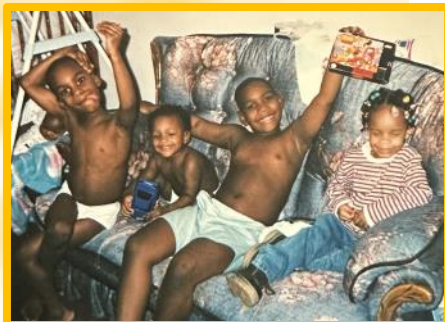

**Diana Lynn enjoyed shopping, cooking, movies, praying for everyone, and loved to dance with her family at gatherings.**

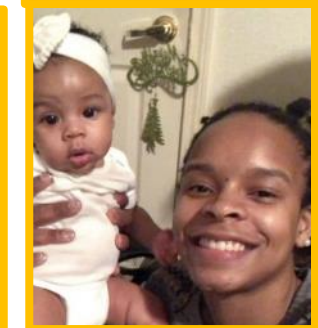
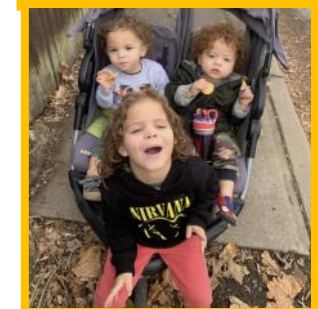
**She departed this life on Saturday, June 24, 2023. Her parents, eight of her siblings, and several aunts, uncles, and cousins preceded her in death.**
