Christ in Passover Celebration

We will explore what the Passover would have been like for Christ and how the symbols he used, we still refer to today. The meal we share will be like that which Christ and his disciples shared at the last supper. Please, nothing with leavening. No bread, crackers, doughnuts, cake, graham cracker crust, croutons or bread crumbs. Anything with baking powder, baking soda or yeast as those are all considered leavened.

Foods that are great for Passover are items such as salad (no croutons) pasta dishes, potatoes, fruit salads, bean dishes, quinoa dishes, rice dishes, vegetables (fresh or roasted), vegetarian dishes as long as they don't contain leavening. Desserts; again please use no leavening. We will see you here!

Are you supporting your local church budget in addition to the world church?

Most of us have been convicted of the biblical need to pay our tithe and many of us are faithful to that process. Some of us, however, have forgotten that tithe supports only the corporate church, which we are called to do, however, it does not support the local church budget. It is our local church budget that pays for things like our electric and water bills, etc. So, something for you to think about, for the Eastgate SDA Church, for the period from February 7 to March 7, our electrical costs averaged \$56.47 per day over that billing period. That is with all of the rooms reduced in temperature during the week except for Sabbath morning! For the first three months of the year we have averaged \$9,538.32 with a monthly budget of \$10,414. Please consider contributing to our local church budget and support the local ministry of this church. Thank you!


