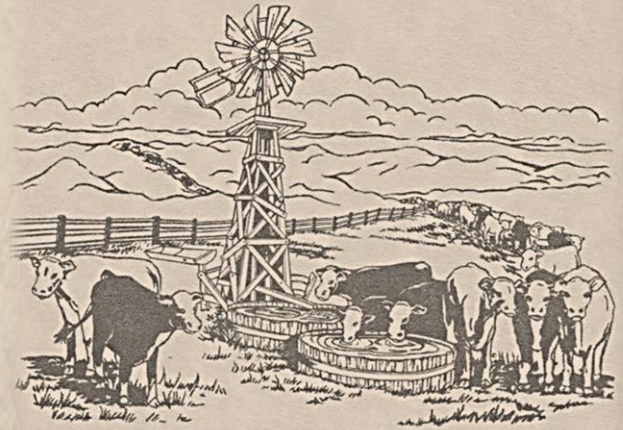


OBITUARY

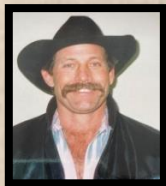
