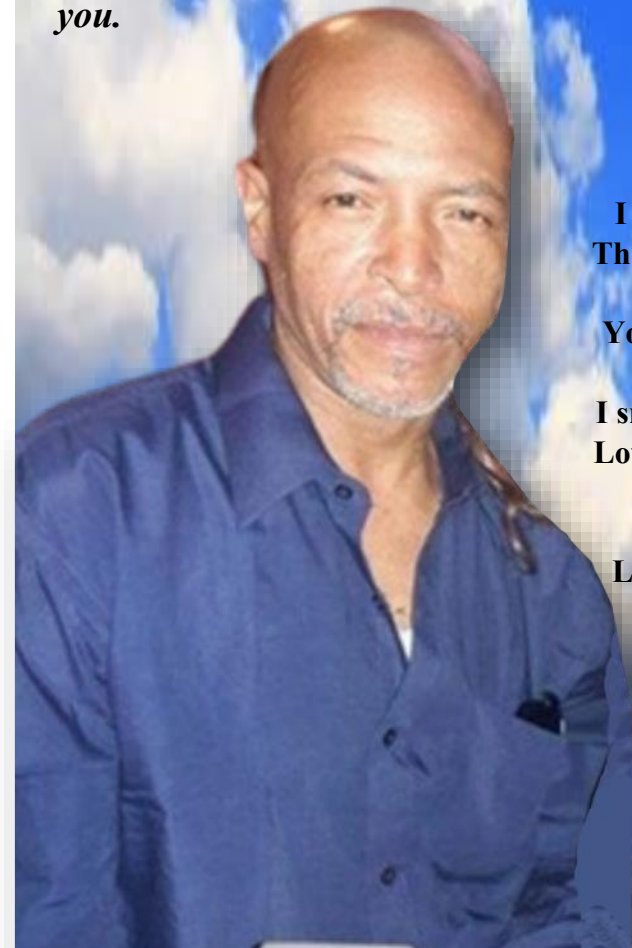

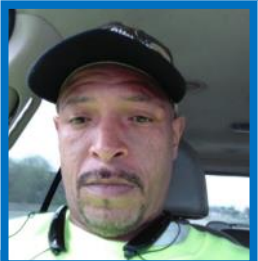
Reflections of His Life
