Will comfort you, from day to day.*

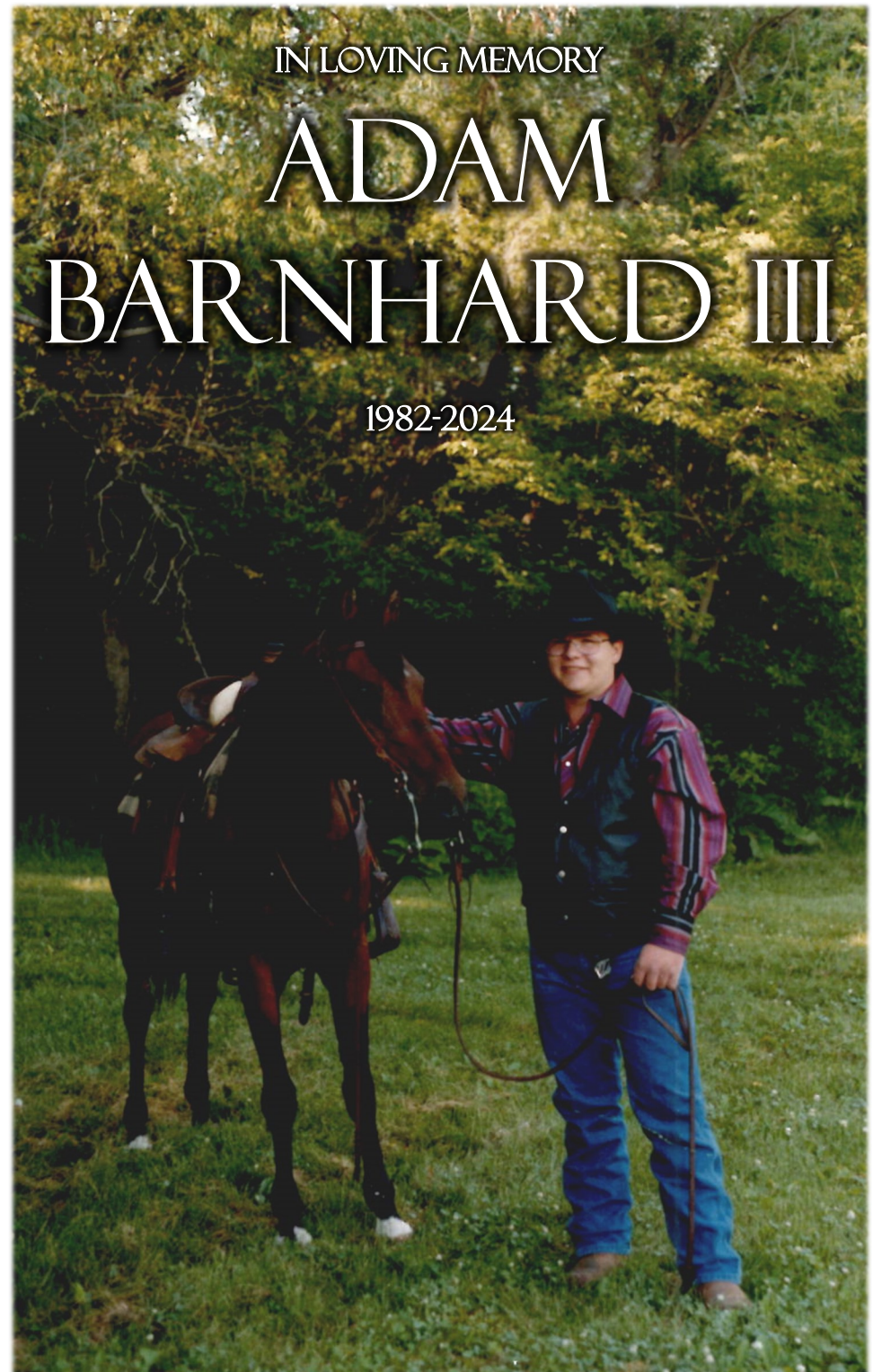
*You'll feel his presence in the breeze,
