Remain closed for the month of December until further notice.

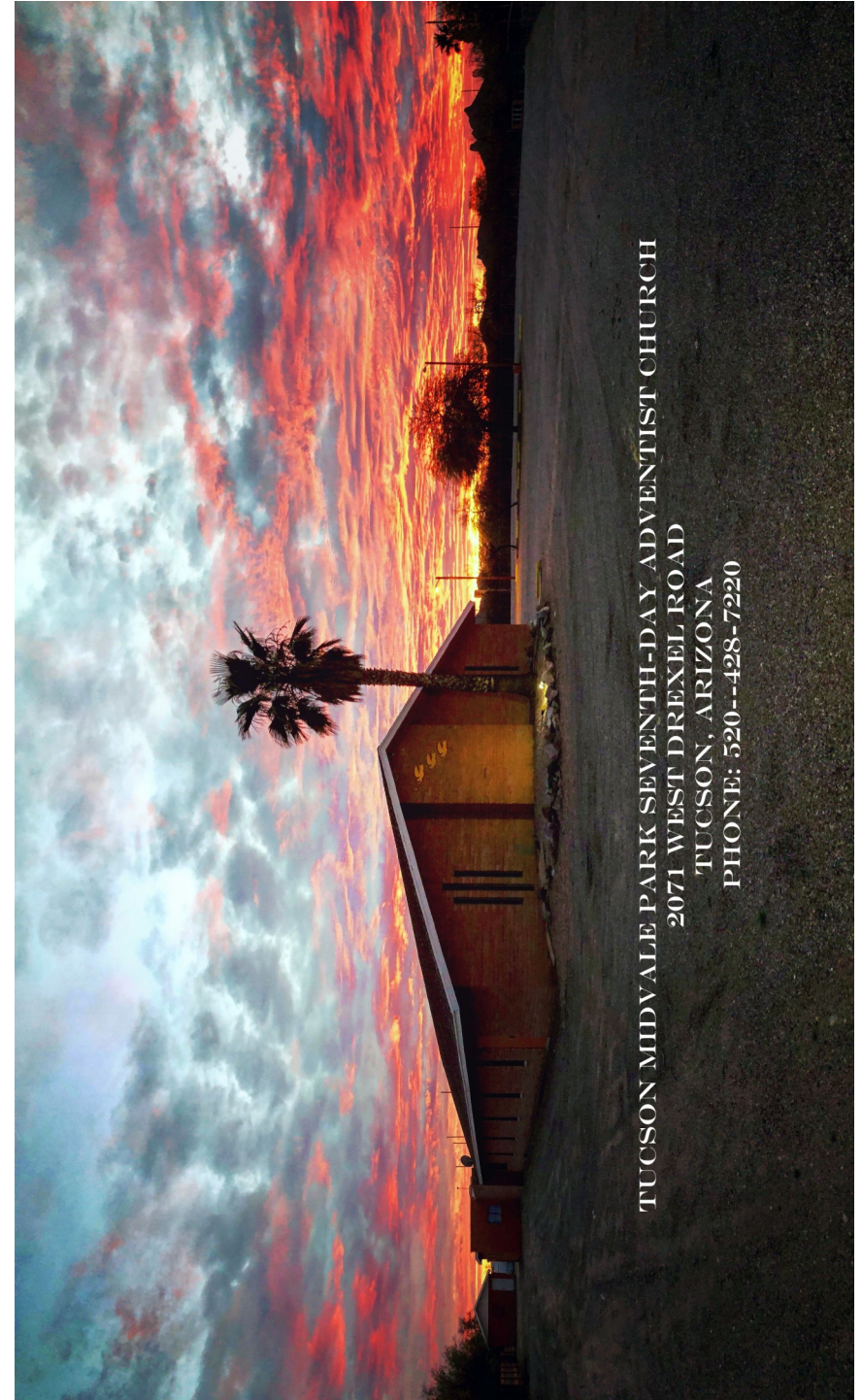
