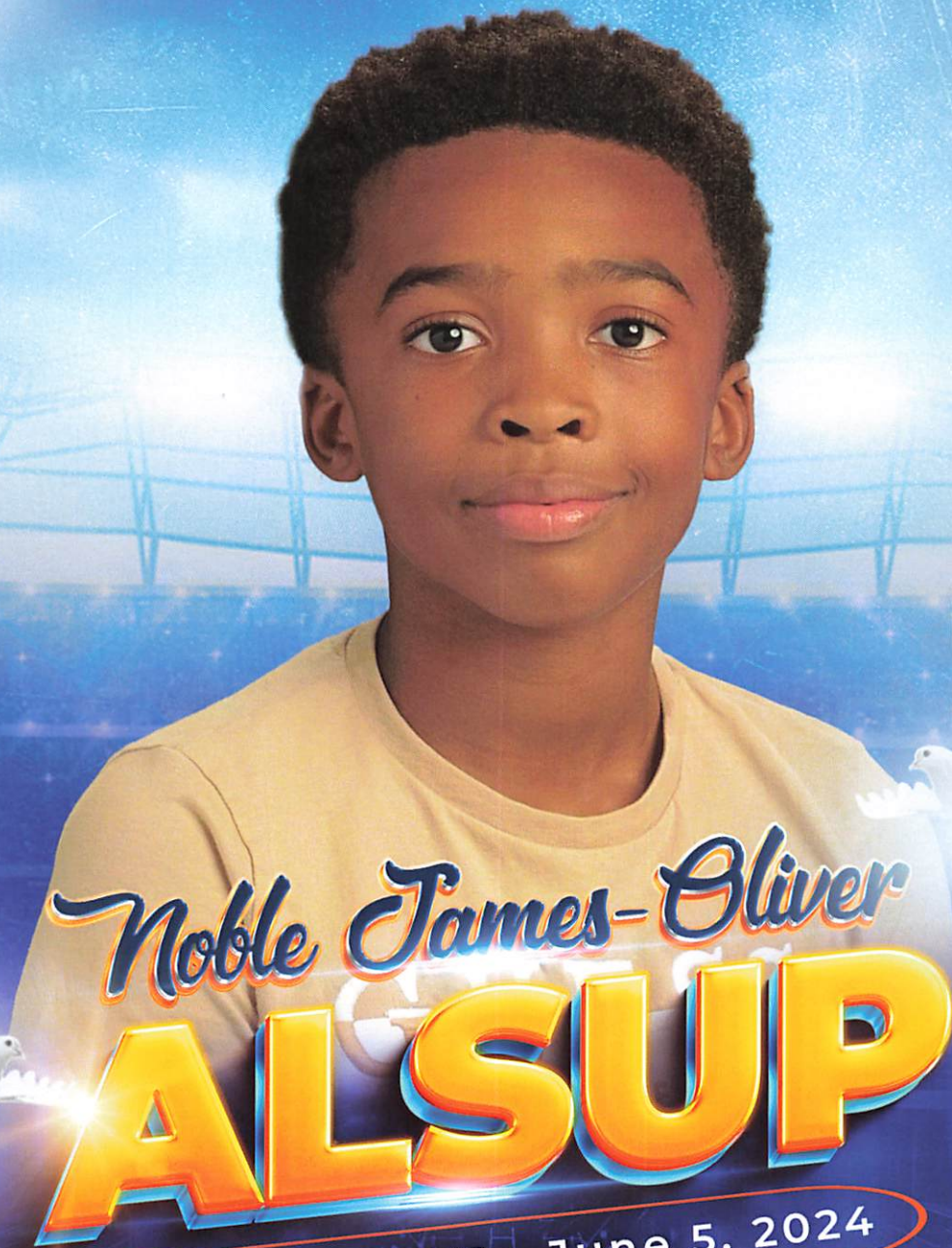

Remembering NOBLE

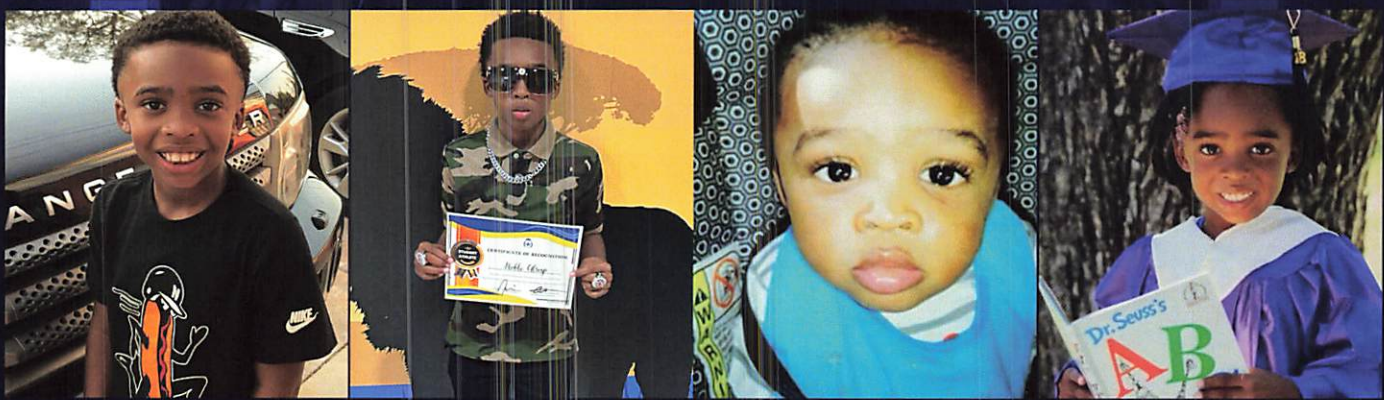

He is preceded in death by his grandfather Mitchell Davis and great-great grandmother Winnie Milligan.



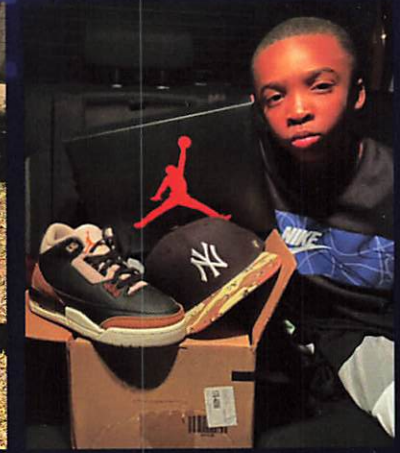
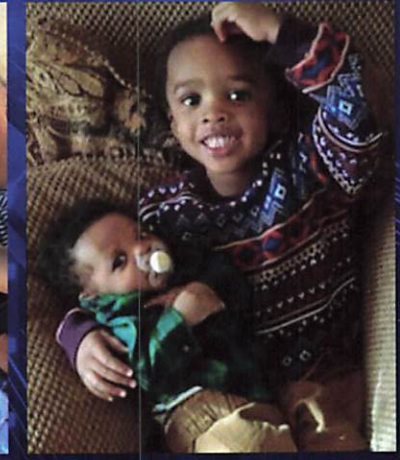
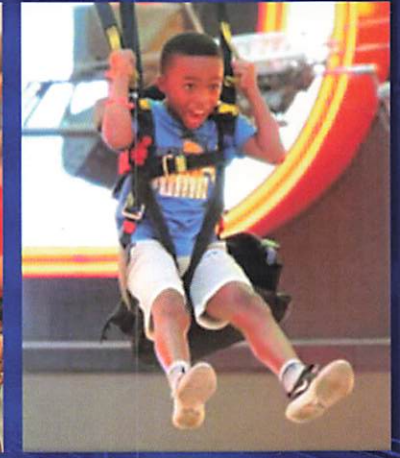
