6. If you begin to experience any flu-like symptoms, please self-quarantine at home until the matter is properly resolved.

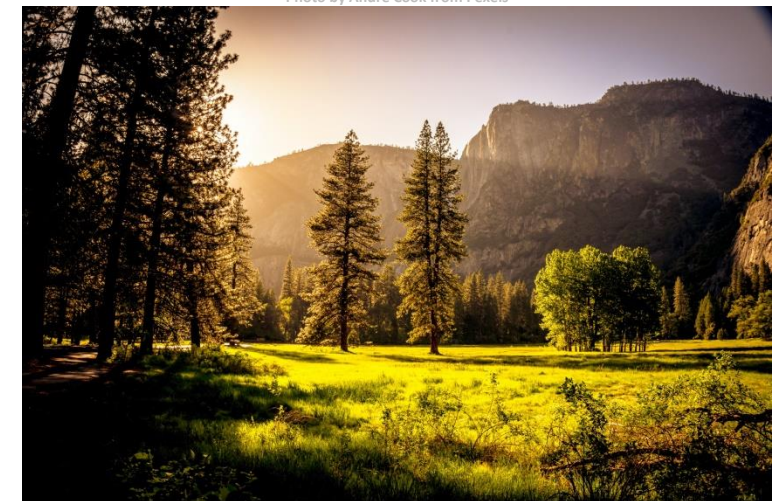
