



Levi was educated in the Bryan County public school system. He worked for over 30 years for Louis C. Matthews Seafood Market, Inc. where he served in various positions, including assistant manager.

He was married to Louise G. Hagans for 47 years. This wonderful union created a blended family with five sons, including Levi, Jr. God later blessed them with a bouncing baby boy, providing them with six sons, which made for countless sparring sessions and debates over sport topics and sporting events over the years.

While away from his day job, Levi engaged in various recreational hobbies.
