He leads me beside still waters.

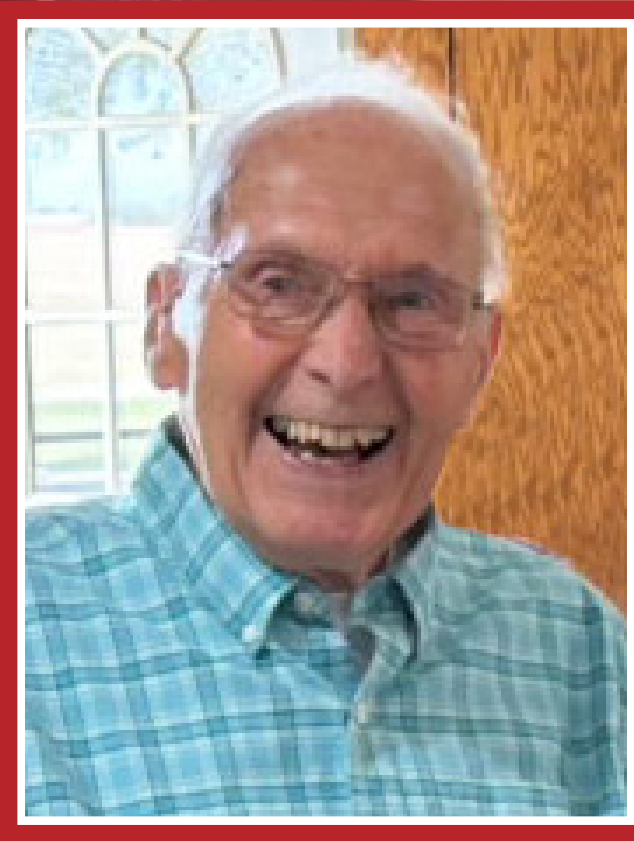
He restores my soul. He leads me in paths

Lyle H. Doege, 90, of Woden, passed away Saturday, August 31, 2024, at Westview Care Center in Britt.

He graduated from Woden High School in 1951 and continued his education at Waldorf College where he played baseball. After college, he served in the US Navy for two years being stationed in Guam.
