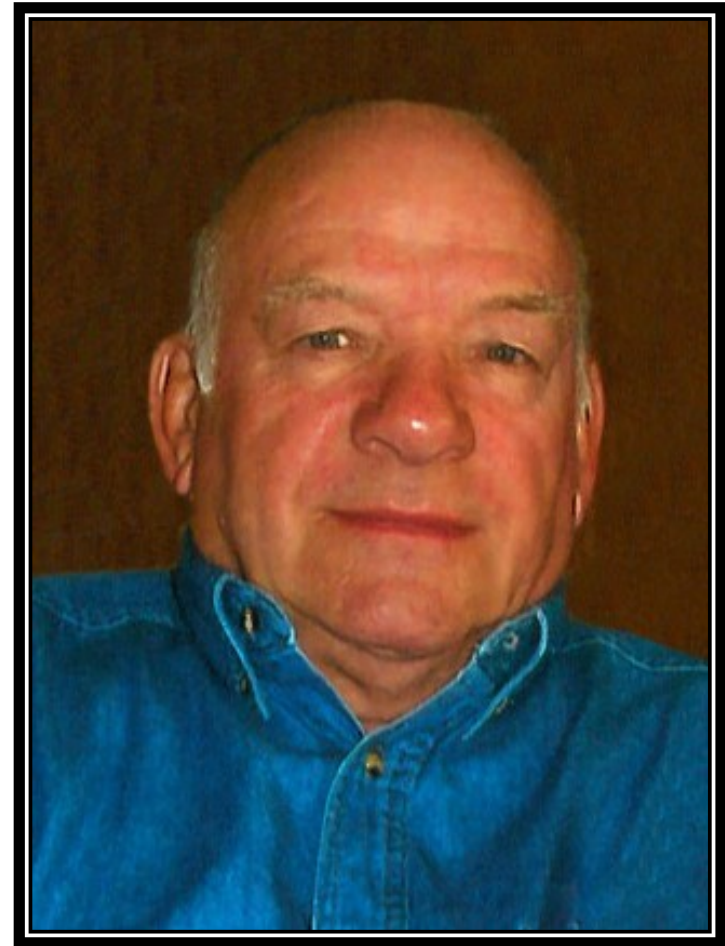


## *If You Could See Me Now*
