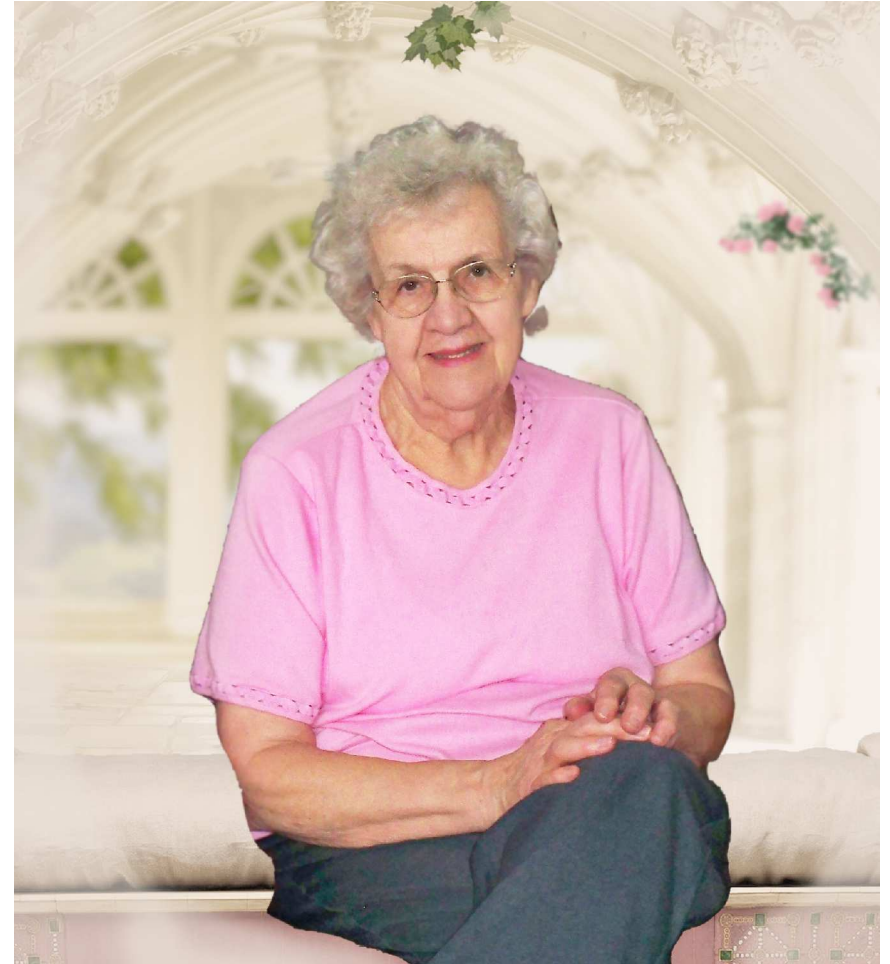

Gods Garden
