Rev Alan writes...

Happy Easter - He has Risen! He has Risen Indeed, Alleluia! The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ are the most significant

events in the history of the world, bringing hope and life for us all. So, it is a cause for celebration! At our Easter Sunday morning services at each fellowship, we will be looking at the story of the empty tomb and Jesus' resurrection in Luke 24:1-12.



And our Sunday evening 6.30pm Parish-wide service at St Peter's will be a glorious Easter celebration with Communion, and I will be speaking on the theme: "Freedom in the Risen Christ - We are a Resurrection People!" from 1 Corinthians 15:12-20.



Next week we start a new 8week sermon series called The Mission of My Church, looking at the Book of Acts. The Book of Acts is the sequel to the

Gospel of Luke. Where Luke's gospel dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, the Book of Acts reveals that Jesus wasn't finished doing and teaching even after His crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension.

We have learnt that Jesus' Church is Jesus' family on Jesus' mission. This means that being a part of Jesus' family requires participating in Jesus' mission. We can't be a part of Jesus' family and ignore His mission. Acts 1:8 reminds us that Jesus' mission is to see the gospel proclaimed to all peoples and so it is the challenge to us as the Church is to be witnesses of all that He has done.
