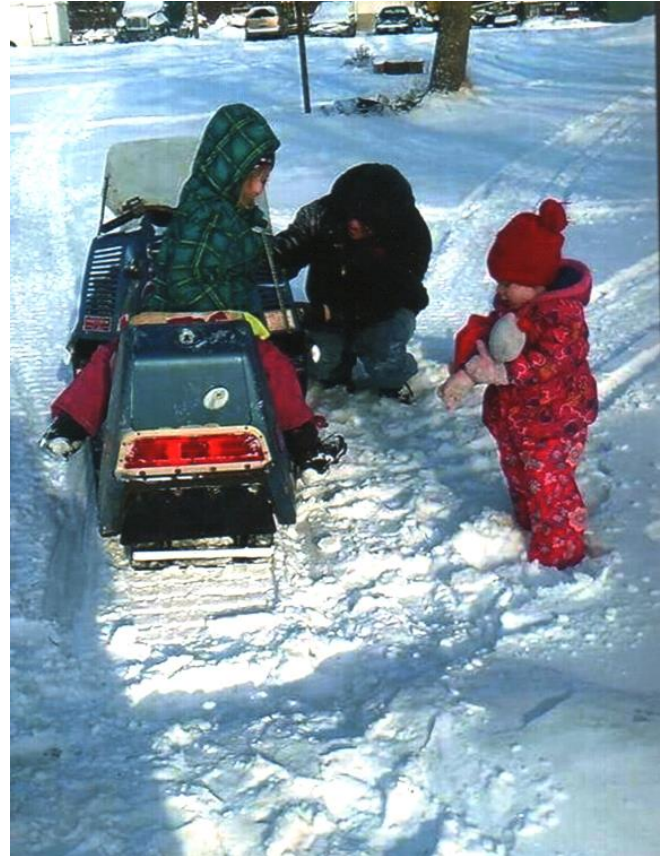


Remembering The Life Of
