Hot Lunch

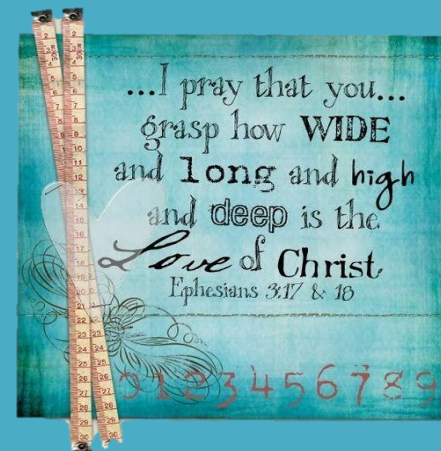
