## Parents of 7th/8th Graders Important info for college scholarships

Want to help your child attend college? The College Bound Scholarship was created by the State of Washington to provide state-funded financial aid to low income families who may not have considered sending their child to college because of the cost.

Apply for the College Bound Scholarship now. If your child is an eligible 7th or 8th grader, complete an application by June 30 of their 8th grade year. Apply online and learn more about eligibility requirements at [collegebound.wa.gov](http://collegebound.wa.gov).

More than 300,000 students have applied to be part of the program and received up to \$47,600 over four years.

The College Bound Scholarship has helped many students attend and graduate from Walla Walla University.

## Open House and New Student Carnival

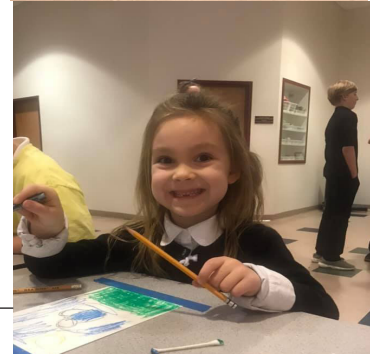
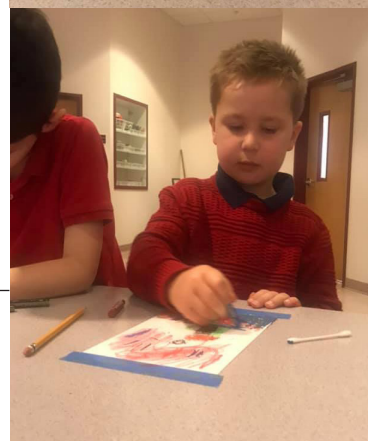
Know someone who needs to attend Rogers? Invite them to our Open House and New Student Carnival on Thursday, March 12 from 6-7:30 in the RAS gym.
