Buchanan City Hall to Re-open on Monday, June 15, 2020

Buchanan, June 12, 2020: After being closed to the public for several months, the City of Buchanan will re-open to the public on a limited basis beginning Monday, June 15.

The lobby will be open the public for window transactions beginning with the following precautions:

- Only 1 person or family unit will be allowed in the lobby at a time
- Markings on sidewalk to remind those waiting outside to observe social distance
- Hand sanitizer will be available on window counter
- The public is encouraged to bring their own pen
- The counter and window area will be regularly sanitized

Continued use of the drop box and online payment methods are strongly encouraged in order to minimize exposure and wait times.

Office access will remain by appointment or permission only with the following precautions:

- Visitors must complete a health self-screen prior to entry
- Secured/buzzer access
- Sign in
- Mask covering nose and mouth required in common areas and in offices when unable to maintain social distance

Virtual public meetings are allowed by Executive Order through June 30. We are currently evaluating what precautions need to be in place to accommodate future in-person public meetings.
