

Cry for Me Not

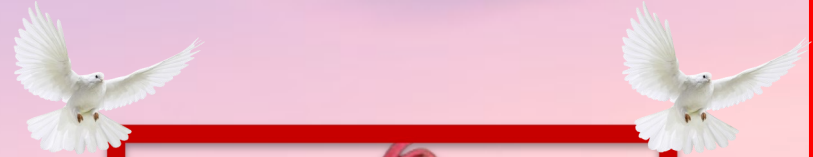
Sad and down I expect you will be, now that I'm gone

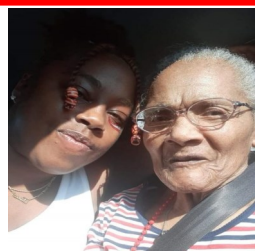
Maryellen's Life Story
