Dear Directors:

The Adventurer Family Camp is coming up soon and I hope that your club will be able to attend this year!

The Theme this year is “Jesus In Nature.” In order to have a smooth weekend, I would like to meet with the director or a representative from your club a week before Adventurer Camp begins at the Conference Office. **Please take note of the meeting dates:** For clubs attending the May 31- June 2 Camp, please meet on Sabbath, May 25, at 6 p.m. For clubs attending the June 21-23 Camp, please meet on Sabbath, June 15, at 6 p.m. If your club is not represented at the designated meeting above, your security deposit will be forfeited. At the meeting, you will receive important information: schedule, meal times, activities, lodging assignments, wrist bands, Award, Chip & Star class schedule and locations.

Enclosed you will find the following: 1) An information packet. 2) A medical consent form to be copied and filled out for each child. 3) Lodge & Cabin Registration Form. 4) Activity & Graduation Forms

Lodge and cabin registration forms from clubs will be on a first-come first-serve basis. Full payment must be received with your registration form. **Registration will close when all beds are taken. Register early to avoid disappointment.** When camp is full no more registration forms will be accepted even if it is before the due date. NO REFUNDS once a club is registered.

We will assign cabins and lodge rooms, but you may suggest your preference. You will be assigned beds and it is up to you how you give the beds to your members. Small Cabins are only available in May. Please notice the varied costs for the number of people in small cabins – up to 4.

We are encouraging clubs to take their Adventurers “Star Gazing” at the upper parking lot or the horse coral at 9 p.m. Saturday night. For this event the top gate will not be opened until after 10 p.m.

If any of your parents or staff need to leave the camp between 9 p.m. Friday night to 10 p.m. Saturday night, please have them park their cars above the top gate coming down from Highway 38. The Gate will be LOCKED. Cars will not be able to leave the camp below the top gate until 10 p.m. Saturday night.

If your club members are planning to arrive AFTER 10 pm. Friday night, the TOP GATE will be LOCKED for safety reasons. Vehicles will be parked at the top gate and individuals will walk down to the camp.

The method of payment is as follows: cash, church check or billing your church. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS.** Please note that if you want to bill your church, you **must** have your church treasurer send an email to brichards@sccsda.org authorizing the charge for Adventurer Family Camp. If we bill your church, you will be billed for the registered number even if you have cancellations. The **registration deadline Thursday, MAY 16, for both family camps.** After the deadline, there will be a \$10.00 late fee per person.

ADVENTURER FAMILY CAMP CHECKLIST

- Theme:** “Jesus In Nature”
- Activities:** Each club will provide one activity (award, chip, star, or craft) that should be Sabbath appropriate. You might be asked to change your activity if too many clubs want to teach the same class, or we have too many for an age level.

An introduction of the activity can be offered. The activity might not be completed but the child’s club can finish it at their own club meetings. The craft, if taken, should be very simple and the Adventurer will take the craft with them.

Before the due date of the respective Family Camps a list of activities will be compiled from the individual clubs’ Activity Forms.

Due Dates for enclosed Activity Form:

May 31 Family Camp I: Thursday, May 16

June 21 Family Camp II: Wednesday, June 3

After the activity forms are turned into our office, there will be a Sign-up Form emailed to you so you can sign your children up for the award or craft of their desire. You will **return the Sign-Up Form** by email or fax (or phone in your sign-ups) to our office no later than the **May 22 (Family Camp I) or June 11 (Family Camp II)**. We will give to you the completed activity schedule at the meeting at conference office, with the number of children in each activity, so you will know how many children will be in your activity and plan for your supplies accordingly. (See Sabbath Afternoon for details.)

- Application Changes:** Once a club has submitted a registration form with payment of fees and deposit, that club is now considered registered and accommodations reserved. **A club may add individuals but may not cancel the number that has already been paid.** Any additional persons added will require the director to **re-submit a new registration form with the added information and the additional fees due** to cover the add-

ons. No changes or cross-outs with pencil or pen on application-- a new form will need to be turned in if changes need to be made. There will be a \$10.00 late fee for every individual added after the deadline (May 16). Do not phone or email changes; send a hard copy with any additions.

Cafeteria: When the line begins to form for the cafeteria, please go to the back of the line. Do not cut in line while waiting to go in the cafeteria. Do not save spaces for anyone. You will lose your security deposit if this courtesy is not followed. We will stagger the clubs as to the time to enter the café for meals. Please cooperate and come when your assigned time is given. Clubs will be assigned a time to eat on a rotating schedule. There is no meal served on Friday, so plan accordingly.

Cafeteria Food: Please, please DO NOT take any food out of the Cafeteria. No take-out plates will be given. You will lose your Security Deposit if food is taken out of the Cafeteria.

Camp Check-in: When you arrive at camp, clubs may go directly to their cabins. Check-in at Headquarters, Friday from 4 – 9 p.m. to pick up the keys for the Lodge and for the director to Check-In at Headquarters to let us know that your club is present. Please plan to be at camp before 10:00 p.m., as the hilltop gate will be locked for safety at 10:00 p.m. The first activity will begin Friday at 8:30 p.m. either at the Fire Bowl or Nature Center depending on the weather. If directors/ staff/parents arrive after 10:00 p.m., instruct your club they will need to PARK at the Upper Hilltop Gate and walk down to camp.

Cancellations: **No refunds** for club cancellations or individuals who did not come. It will be counted as a donation to the Adventurer Program.

Cars: No cars are to be driven around camp after a club registers at camp. Do not park on the road in front of the bathroom in the South Village. Your club will lose their deposit. Those leaving the camp early will need to make prior arrangements. If you need to leave before Saturday at 10:00 p.m. arrangements have to be made with Pastor Bob before you arrive at camp! If you need to leave early, park above the Upper Hilltop Gate.

Children: Children 2-3 years of age staying in cabins will pay \$40 and \$135 in the Lodge for the weekend. This includes food.

Club of the Year: For those interested in qualifying for “Adventurer Club of the

Year” you must attend one of these Family Camps with 80% of your club in attendance.

Club Participation:

Clubs attending camp must participate with the scheduled events throughout the weekend. There is free time in which clubs may do what they choose.

Cooking:

Because of animals, rodents, and fire danger we will not permit any cooking of any kind in the cabins or lodge. Please eat Friday evening before arriving at camp.

Cost:

Large Cabin:

Large cabin – Two nights plus four meals:

Adults/Adventurers:	\$80.00 per person
2-3 years old	\$40.00 per person

Small Cabin: (available in May only)

Small cabin – Two nights plus four meals:

Adults/Adventurers:	
\$110 to \$120 per person (see registration form)	
2-3 years old	\$95.00 per person

Due Dates:

Both Family Camp registration form due dates are May 16. **Please note that the due date is the same for both camps. Register early to avoid disappointment.** Your club Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. When camp is full no more applications will be accepted even if it is before the due date.

If you are mailing the application or adding on to your registration, the paperwork and payment **must arrive at the office on or before the due date of May 16.** There will be no phone, email or faxed registrations or changes.

Early Departures:

If you have parents or staff leaving early, they will pay the full amount as a weekend camper. There is **no** discount for one-night lodging or fewer meals eaten.

Emergency Medical Treatment Authorization Form:

This form is required only if you have children coming with your club under 18 years of age. This form gives medical personnel permission to perform emergency medical treatment if the child gets hurt and a parent is not present to authorize permission. Each club director must have in their possession these forms at all times. Your club is responsible for taking care of their own emergency needs. There will be no medical personnel available at camp. (form at end of

packet)

- Food:** No food or snacks in the cabins or lodge. This includes drinks of any kind. We have an abundance of wild animals and mice and this encourages them to come into the buildings. Eat your Friday evening meal before arriving at camp. Please do not take any food out of the cafeteria and do not eat snacks or drink at activities & meetings. You will lose your security deposit if the food or drinks are found in cabins or lodge. Please help us control the rodents on the camp grounds.
- Fires:** No fires of any kind are allowed at camp!!! Please let everyone in your group know the importance of not starting a fire. Clubs will be fined \$100 if this rule is broken.
- First Aid:** Each club needs to bring their own first-aid kit. This is very important!!! Each club is responsible for taking care of their own emergency needs. There will be no medical personnel available. You will provide your own medical personnel to be available for your club.
- Gate:** This is a contention every year. Please do not have members come or leave between Friday 10:00 p.m. till Saturday night 10:00 p.m. Make plans accordingly. If your members come after the gate is locked – they will park their vehicle at the Top Gate and walk down to the camp. The Gate will not be opened until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday night due to the Star Gazing event and Adventurers will be walking on the road.
- Graduation:** A graduation ceremony will be held after church service for those who are nine years old or in Helping Hand Class. A graduation certificate will be given to those who pre-register. No last-minute registration.
- Hospital Authorization Form:** Enclosed is a hospital authorization form if an emergency occurs. Fill out this form and give to the E.R. No payment for services will be required. (See Form at end of packet)
- Late Arrivals:** The late arrivals may have to walk down the hill. Gate will be closed Friday night at 10:00 p.m. Gate will be opened at 10:00 p.m. Saturday night.
- Late Fee:** If you register after **May 16** there will be a \$10 per person late registration fee. If your mailed application or fees arrive at our office after the due date, it will be considered late and there will be a late fee added. Add-ons are considered late if after May 16. **Please note the due date for registration is**

the same for both camps. All applications need to be in the Youth Ministries Office on or before the due date to avoid the late fee.

Limited Space: Register early! Don't wait for the deadline because it may be too late. Once our cabin and lodge beds have been reserved, we will not accept any more applications.

Lodge Price: Prices include four meals and two nights lodging. Rooms will not be assigned without full payment, which must be enclosed with your application. No phone, email, or fax registrations. Children are not to be left alone in the Lobby of the Lodge at any time.

Names of all occupants and the ages of the children must be included with the Lodge Registration. Children 2-3 years old will pay the \$135 cost as an extra person, which also includes meals.

Meals: All children must have an adult with them at every meal including securing the food and lining up at the entrance door. Adults, please help the children at the salad bar and getting their drinks. There is to be no eating or cooking in the lodge or cabins. No food or drink to be taken out of the cafeteria. You will lose your deposit.

Nature Nugget This activity takes the place of Walk Thru the Bible. Four Clubs will offer a 10-minute lesson in Nature. Clubs will rotate to different locations. If your club would like to sign-up for the Nature Nugget, please fill-out the bottom of the Activity Form. The Lower Nature Center will be one of the five locations that the clubs will have an opportunity to explore.

Parade: At 9:30 a.m. on Sabbath, all will meet in the fire bowl. The Adventurers with staff will march in Class A uniform around camp in a given route. If your club does not have Class A uniforms, you are welcome to march, but Sabbath clothes are acceptable.

Pets: Do not bring any pets to camp (i.e.: dogs, cats, birds, snakes, etc.)

Points: In order to receive the conference points at least 80% of staff and Adventurers must be in attendance from your club.

Refunds: There will be no refunds for camp cancellations or individuals who did not come. It will be counted as a

donation to the Adventurer Program.

- Registration:** The Youth Ministries Department will assign all lodging. If any applications are received after May 16, you will pay a late penalty fee of **\$10 per person**. We need to give Camp Cedar Falls a final meal count one week ahead of camp dates, so it is very important for you to register on time. **Please note that the due date is the same for both camps.**
- Sabbath Afternoon:** Each Club is required to offer an Award, Chip, Star or Craft at the scheduled time. Plan to present an Award, Chip, Star or Craft related to Nature.
- Sabbath Observance:** Please – no ball playing, Frisbee throwing, etc., on Sabbath.
- Sabbath School:** Sabbath School will be provided by your own club.
- Saturday Night Activity:** There will be 3 different activities available: Games, Movie and Camp Store will be Open. Each club will plan a CARNIVAL Type Game or Activity for Saturday Night on the Field. The Adventurers will go with their parent(s) to each club area and rotate from club to club for games, activities, etc. that each club will provide for the evening. Examples of Activities: Ball Toss, Ring Toss, Face Painting, Egg Toss, Table Games, Bean Bag Toss, Disc Toss, Art/Drawing, etc. The MOVIE will be presented at the Fire Bowl. **THE CAMP STORE WILL BE OPEN.**
- Security Deposit:** Send your application form and payment, along with a \$50 security deposit, to the Youth Ministries Department.
- Security Deposit Refund:** Each club's \$50 security deposit will be returned in a refund certificate if there are no damages and no behavior problems. This certificate will be valid for only one year from the date given to use when you purchase items from the Youth Ministries Dept. or use for a Deposit on another event.
- Small Cabins:** Small cabins are available **only for the weekend of May 31-June 2 (Family Camp I)**. During Family Camp II the summer camp staff will be utilizing the small cabins. Please see the registration form for per person costs.
- Sunday Activities at CCF:** Volleyball, Soccer, Basketball, and Swimming will be available weather permitting on Sunday.
- Sunday Activities at Yucaipa:** If your club would like to explore the Yucaipa area, see enclosed information.

- Supervision:** Campers will need supervision of an adult at **all times**. Stay together as a unit and do things together. Do not let a child go to an activity or outpost without an adult. Children are not to be left alone in a cabin or lodge lobby at anytime.
- Tent Camping:** There will be no outside tent camping because of the danger of animals. Limited space for indoor tent camping (bring your own tents) will be allowed. The cost for tent camping is the same cost as large cabins.
- Trash:** There are no trash cans on the camp grounds because of animals. Bring up all trash from cabins to the trash bins in the back of the cafeteria. **Do not throw trash from your cabin in restroom trash cans.**
- Uniforms:** If your club has Class A Uniforms, please wear them Sabbath morning. If not, Sabbath clothes are to be worn. You may change out of your uniforms after lunch.
- Visitors:** Because of a full camp, no visitors are allowed and especially on Sabbath! PLEASE DO NOT ASK. The hilltop gate will be locked after 10:00 p.m. on Friday through Saturday night at 10:00 p.m. **Please let your pastors and parents know this rule.** We do not want anyone to drive all the way to Camp Cedar Falls only to be turned away.
- What to Bring:** Warm jacket, comfortable shoes, Class A Uniform or Sabbath Clothes, warm sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight, swimming suit, toothbrush and paste, towels, toiletries, lip balm, soap, insect repellent, cash for camp store, etc.
