

Message of Encouragement: by Rich Carlson

For He knows how we are made; He remembers that we are dust. Psalm 103:14

This morning, when I read this I was reminded of God's goodness and kindness. Someone asked me the other day why I loved God and my immediate response was, "Because He is so kind and loving to those who have any interest in loving Him back." ANY interest! Not a perfected interest! ANY interest. And His kindness is reflected in my verse today, "He knows how we are made; He remembers that we are dust." I love God because He understands my weakness and is MORE than willing to walk with me and guide me on the frail and fragile journey through life with sometimes more downs than ups. But He understands, and if I am willing He'll hang in there with me all the way.

I think He has big plans and dreams for me and everyone else but He understands that I can get easily distracted, even with good things, and forget the best things, like eternal life being more valuable than things in this temporal life. He knows I can be weak, but He loves me anyway, and knows how strong I can be when I admit it. According to Paul in his second letter to the people in Corinth, "When I am weak, then I am strong."

Paul also reminded me this morning that, *It is the kindness of God that leads to repentance.* (Romans 2:4) If I want to challenge anyone with the need for repentance it's not about hell-fire and brimstone, but about His kindness! The only people in the Bible I don't see the kindness of Jesus toward are hypocrites. They are NOT sinners struggling through life and making poor choices along the way; they're people who consciously claim to be followers of God while consciously choosing to live life like they are not whenever it's for their own personal gain. Those Jesus did not have much time for, but to everyone else I see His kind and understanding heart poured out without measure.
