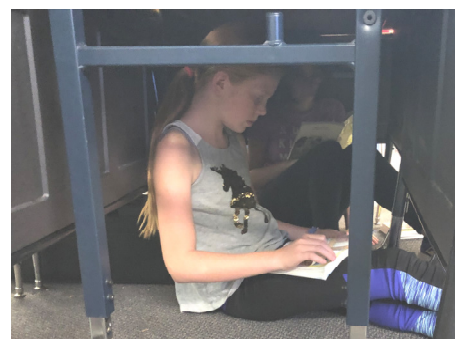

**RESCHEDULED RETAKE PICTURES** - Fall Portraits, Wednesday, October 30 ~ Don't forget your smiles!

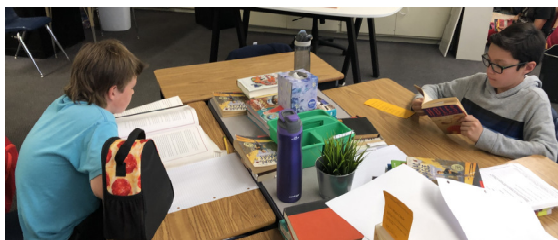
