Use of the Internet

Students at MAS will gain skills which will allow them to become independent, responsible users of the Internet. The teacher will supervise and model appropriate use of the Internet. Internet access will be under direct teacher supervision. Safety controls are in place to block certain websites. Students will use the Internet only with permission from the teacher.

Responsible Use of the Internet

The Internet is a valuable educational resource for students. Internet use and access is a privilege. Anyone who uses school Internet access in an inappropriate manner will lose this privilege. Students are expected to abide by the following guidelines:

1. Use of school facilities and equipment are only for school-related, educational activities. Accessing personal email, social networking accounts, personal "shopping", or browsing is not allowed.
2. Students will be polite and use appropriate language.
3. Students will maintain individual anonymity and privacy. They will not reveal personal addresses or phone numbers.
4. Students will use equipment appropriately. They will no engage in acts of vandalism (malicious attempt to harm or destroy).
5. Students will adhere to copyright laws and restrictions.
