

Weekly Story: "An Angel's Special Secret-"

Craft: "Paper Plate Bird Nest"

Memory Verse: "You shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins." Matthew 1:21

Materials Needed:

- A paper plate
- Felt in green and brown (if you don't have felt, you can use construction paper)
- White paper
- Nature items (grass, straw, or twigs, etc.)
- Sharpie Marker
- Color pencils
- Glue
- Scissors



Instructions:

- 1) Color the top half of the paper plate light blue.
- 2) Cut out a green felt/construction paper bird and glue it on the paper plate.
- 3) Cut out two eggs using a piece of white paper.
- 4) Glue nature items such as grass/moth/straw/twigs on the bottom of the paper plate. You cut brown felt strips and glue them as well.
- 5) Glue the white eggs on top of the felt strips.

Variations:

- You could paint your paper plate blue beforehand for the sky.
 - You can use materials such as craft feathers, yarn, color tissues, Spanish moss for the bird nest.
 - You can go for a nature walk with your parents and look for real bird nests. You can observe to see what kind of materials the birds used to make their nest.
