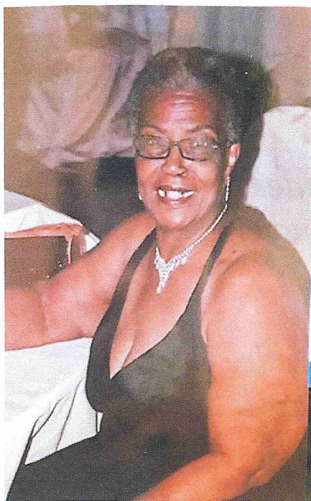


**In Loving Memory Of A Special Husband**
