

Squash Australia Memorandum – 18th February Board Meeting

1. Sun Safe Policy

As we have an outdoor part to our OzSquash Sporting Schools programme and a future Outdoor Squash concept we are required by the ASC to have a Sun Safe Policy. This has been completed and approved by the Squash Australia Board in February.

2. Sporty HQ Rollout

The SportyHQ rollout around Matrix transfer and the new CRM is on track, it is however taking up a significant amount of National and State bandwidth to get everybody across, set up and walk them through the additional capability. Due to this Squash Australia has identified a need for additional support for this project over the next 12 months.

All States have been requested to register interest for additional Squash Australia/SportyHQ support on the ground to help with this transfer – please confirm by the 9th March.

6. Southport Squash Centre

For information – Squash Australia has temporarily taken over the Southport Squash Centre for an interim period, until the Carrara Squash Centre opens in June. This was to ensure the sport did not lose the 100+ players that played regularly at the centre. Howard Halter has been appointed as the interim Centre Manager.

The centre also provides a good base for activation activities during the Commonwealth Games.

7. Annual Awards

Next year's Squash Australia Annual Awards will be on Friday 19th June 2019 at the Mercure Gold Coast, the awards will run alongside the World Doubles Championships and Australian National Championships.

Tickets will sell out and are priced at \$150, but reduced to \$99 for all tickets purchased before June 1st 2018.

8. State Funding Agreement 2018/2019
