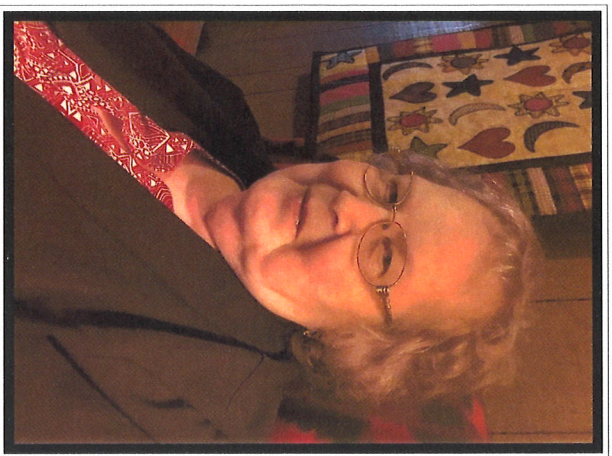


## Never Forget You
