

Following Bennie's death in 1972 Edith continued farming the homestead. In addition to working and managing the farm, she fed the family and hired men. Edith was a longtime member of Nidaros Lutheran Church and the Ladies Aid where she especially enjoyed participating in the Nidaros Fall Suppers. Edith lived at the Olson Family Farm until the last several years of her life.
