He enjoyed many DIY projects, like leatherwork and woodworking, as well as his biggest project, building his home in Chatsworth, CA with brother Harvey's help. He spent much of his life serving others with those skills and talents.

He was a convert to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and often expressed his love and appreciation of his friends amongst his wards. He was also the recipient of a heart transplant 18 years ago which gave him and his family many more years to enjoy together. We express our gratitude to those who made that time possible.
