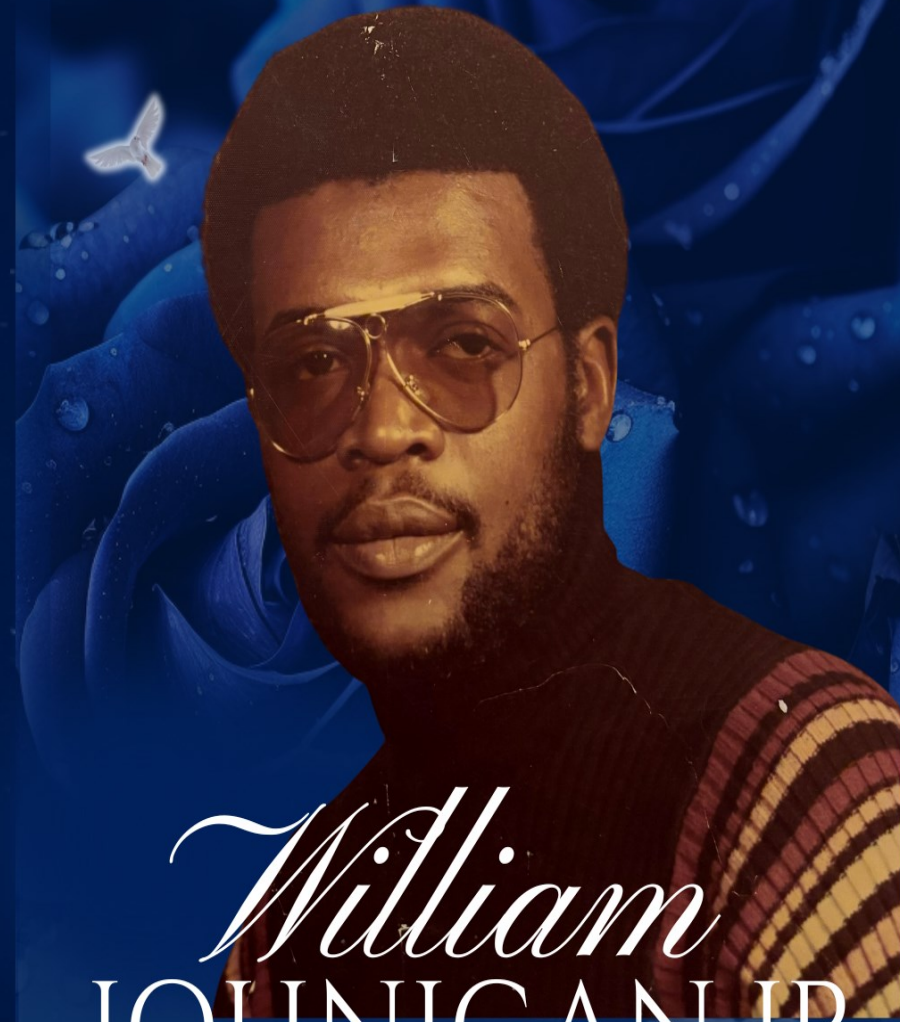

Life Reflections

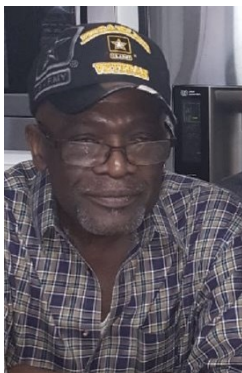
William Johnigan Jr. was born on November 12, 1949, in Kansas City, KS to William and Mildred Johnigan.
