To You My Love

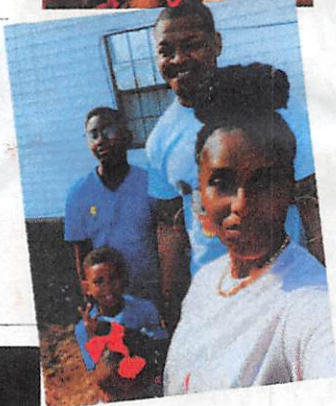
*When tomorrow starts without me,
