WHAT ARE SQUASH BC JUNIOR PATHWAYS EVENTS?

Squash BC Junior Pathways Events are play-based events for junior participants that are not already serviced by our Provincial Junior Gold Series. These events include Tournaments that clear the way for newer competitors by restricting entry to those outside of the top of our provincial rankings and fun-focused tournaments/fairs/festivals that provide an opportunity for newer squash players to experience competition in a safe and welcoming environment using progressive equipment. Hosts of Junior Pathways Events can apply for funding from Squash BC to help cover event costs.



WHAT FUNDING IS AVAILABLE?

Interested coaches and facilities can apply for a Junior Pathways Hosting Grant from Squash BC. These grants include a monetary component, as well as event souvenirs and equipment. Participating event hosts also get access to our Junior Pathways Event Toolkit. The available funding and associated requirements depend on which event type the host applies for:



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JUNIOR PATHWAYS EVENT OPTIONS



The **Squash Starters Tour** is an event series **focused on FUN** where newer junior players can experience squash competition in a **safe and welcoming environment** using **progressive equipment**. Squash Starters events can be structured as a Round Robin Tournament or as a series of timed match rotations. The most important part is keeping participants active and having fun for as much of the event time as possible. Squash Starters need to include at least **three age or level divisions** that each use a different **progressive ball**. Min. Event Time: 3 Hours, Max. Event Time: 1 Day.

Squash Starters hosts can apply for funding from Squash BC to run their event. Facilities can receive **\$300 in funding** to cover event costs, plus a minimum of **six progressive balls** (larger events will receive one ball per division per court used simultaneously for the event). Squash BC will also provide event swag, a custom event poster and social media graphic, and our Squash Starters Event Toolkit.



The **Junior Silver Series** is a regionalized tournament series that allows players outside of the top of Squash BC's provincial ranking system to **compete and experience success**. Silver Series events are tournaments that can use a round robin or straight draw format (Note: **Players must be guaranteed at least two matches**). Players provincially ranked in the top eight of U15, U17 & U19 or the top four of U13 (as of the event registration deadline) are ineligible to participate in the Silver Series. Silver Series event divisions can use either **single dot (competition) or double dot (pro) balls**. Events must be managed through Club Locker and will contribute towards player ratings and provincial rankings. Event Time: 1-2 Days.

Silver Series hosts can apply for funding from Squash BC to run their event. Facilities can receive **\$200 in funding** to cover event costs, plus an **additional \$100** for events with over 30 total participants. Hosts will also receive **12 balls**, Squash BC event swag, and a custom event poster and social media graphic.





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JUNIOR PATHWAYS EVENTS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SQUASH STARTERS TOUR EVENTS

1. Events applications must be submitted at least 30 days in advance to guarantee funding, equipment, and swag are received prior to event dates.
2. Host facilities must be an active Squash BC Facility Member for the 2021/22 Season (in good standing)
3. Host Facilities may apply for multiple Squash Starters Tour Events, but funding may be prioritized for first-time applicants.
4. Hosts that do not complete all grant requirements may be restricted from selection for future event funding.
5. First Disbursement (pre-event):
 - a. Event hosts must complete application form in full to receive funding.
 - b. Event must be planned to include at least three divisions, each targeting a different age group, using a different progressive ball.
6. Second Disbursement (post-event):
 - a. Event hosts must complete the post-event report in full to receive funding
 - b. Event hosts must provide Squash BC with a participant list (including the name, email, age, and gender of all participants) using the participant list template to receive funding
 - c. Event hosts must either provide Squash BC with one or more event photos or post event photos on social media (Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram) and tag @SquashBC in the post to receive funding

JUNIOR SILVER SERIES EVENTS

1. Events applications must be submitted at least 30 days in advance to guarantee funding, equipment, and swag are received prior to event dates.
2. Host facilities must be an active Squash BC Facility Member for the 2021/22 Season (in good standing)
3. Host Facilities may apply for multiple Silver Series Events, but funding may be prioritized for first-time applicants.
4. Hosts that do not complete all grant requirements may be restricted from selection for future event funding.
5. Silver Series Events are required to pay Club Locker, Credit Card Processing, and Squash BC Sanctioning Fees for all participants
6. All event participants must have an active Squash BC Junior Membership
7. First Disbursement:
 - a. Event hosts must complete application form in full to receive funding.
 - b. Event registration must be set up on Club Locker through the Squash BC office.
8. Second Disbursement:
 - a. Event hosts must complete the follow up form in full to receive funding
 - b. Event hosts must confirm Club Locker entry list is accurate to receive funding
 - c. Event hosts must either provide Squash BC with one or more event photos or post event photos on social media (Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram) and tag @SquashBC in the post to receive funding
